Project 1: Personal Website

Objective:

Develop a 3 page personal/portfolio website using a text editor. Your website should include at least a home page (index.html), an about page, and a contact page. It should also use an external CSS file. The website design should conform to current web design standards, and appear the same in all major browsers (Firefox, Chrome, Safari, Internet Explorer/Edge).

Tools and techniques covered in this assignment:

Hand coding a web page using HTML and CSS Organization of website files Formatting web pages (HTML & CSS styles, Head elements) Page layout (Div tags)

The content of your website is entirely at your discretion. It may be either a personal website or a portfolio of your work. Images may be found from online resources or created from scratch. The text on the website should be original. What is most important is that the HTML and CSS is correct, and the images and links work correctly. At a minimum, the website should be at least 3 pages. Each page should have a navigation area and have working links to all of the other pages. **Remember: Save your work and save it often.**

Website requirements: 3 pages, a navigation bar with working links to all of the pages on your website.

Evaluation:

This project will be graded on:

- clean, organized layout and proper organization of files.
- demonstration of technical understanding of HTML and CSS
- all images load correctly
- all navigation elements work properly (no dead links)
